Harvey was a great opportunity for me, obviously. Other performances, before and after that one, helped me to cobble together a sideline in music and theatre — something completely different from work in aerospace, anyway (and, oh yeah, there were girls in those productions). One of the earliest plays was a Max-Shulman creation that flopped on Broadway. At the University of Minnesota, though (where I took a course), it was a hit; the play was based on that setting. I was "Roger Hailfellow" the president of "Alpha Cholera" fraternity.
